# HOME-BASE CARE. DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Follow up of discharged and ex-Nakekela patients in order to support them and their families to adapt at the conditions at home.
- Assist in bed bathing patient if necessary and there is no family support
- Support also in case any first aid or wound care is needed
- Assist in administration of medication
- Assist in educating on healthy eating habits / life style
- Support family also spiritually
- Identifying of prospective patients by doing home visits.
- Reporting patient to the HBC Co-ordinator in order to evaluate condition for possible admission to the Centre or further care at home
- Play role in the admission of patient
- If necessary be the link between family and social services
- Ensure that the patient's bed is made and clean his/her place
- Provide spiritual care and do devotions following the devotional plan
- Support patients in consultation with HBC Co-ordinator to attend clinic/hospital appointments in case they are immobile or have nobody to assist.
- In case of a license in transporting people HBC worker can be requested to support at times with transport by using the company vehicle.
- Write a complete report on every case and hand in when meeting with HBC Co-ordinator
- Report HIV+ children/HIV+ babies in need immediately to the HBC Co-ordinator in order for follow-ups by co-ordinator or doctor
- Identify and report any possibilities in addressing woman's groups as well as youth groups on HIV/AIDS issues and other life skills issues to the co-ordinator in order to follow

  – up and arrange educational sessions.
